



PHOTOGRAPHER'S GUIDELINES

Please always think of safety first. Please seek out the NJMP Security personnel for any clarity.

All photographers must display their media credentials in plain sight and properly wear the NJMP vests at all times. A driver's license and/or credit card info may be required as deposit for issuance of a NJMP photo vest and will be returned upon return of the vest and credentials. If an NJMP media vest is not returned, the credit card on file will be charged.

Getting Around

- Please honor the access and no-access zones on the provided maps.
- The yellow zones are pass through only during a cold track.
- Access to approved shooting locations will be via approved access gates only. Where there is a Flag Station, there is an access gate
- Any photographers shooting from restricted areas risk the possible revoking of media credentials
- No photographer shall cross the racing surface on a hot or cold track unless they have specific approval from race control through the corner marshal, and under supervision of Security

Prohibited Items and Actions:

- Chapter 62 NJ Racing Regulations require no shorts, open-toed shoes, or sleeveless shirts while in the pits or track hot zones
- Consumption of alcoholic beverages by media/photographers is prohibited
- Please do not sit, stand, or hang/put equipment on pit walls, fences, or guardrails
- Tripods and monopods are not permitted when shooting pit stops
- The use of step stools or ladders is not allowed anywhere within the spectator fence, or the pits
- Do not climb over any fence, tire barrier, or other type of barrier
- The use of personal vehicles such as scooters, bikes, etc. are not permitted while on the trackside of the fence
- If your position interferes with a course marshal or a corner/flag worker, you may be asked to move
- Please be aware of the needs of your fellow photographers, and do not intrude into their line of sight
- No running toward an active accident scene
- NO DRONES

In case of an Emergency:

Always be aware of where you are, especially in the pits, and plan your escape route in advance. In the event of a pit fire or emergency, please leave the area immediately to allow emergency personnel to do their work. Please do not run towards a fire to take a photograph. Please be professional at all times. When the call comes to clear the grid, do so promptly. Please remember that your safety and the safety of others are of the highest priority. NJMP Security will have the final say on safety issues. If these guidelines are not followed, it could result in the loss of photo location and/or credentials.

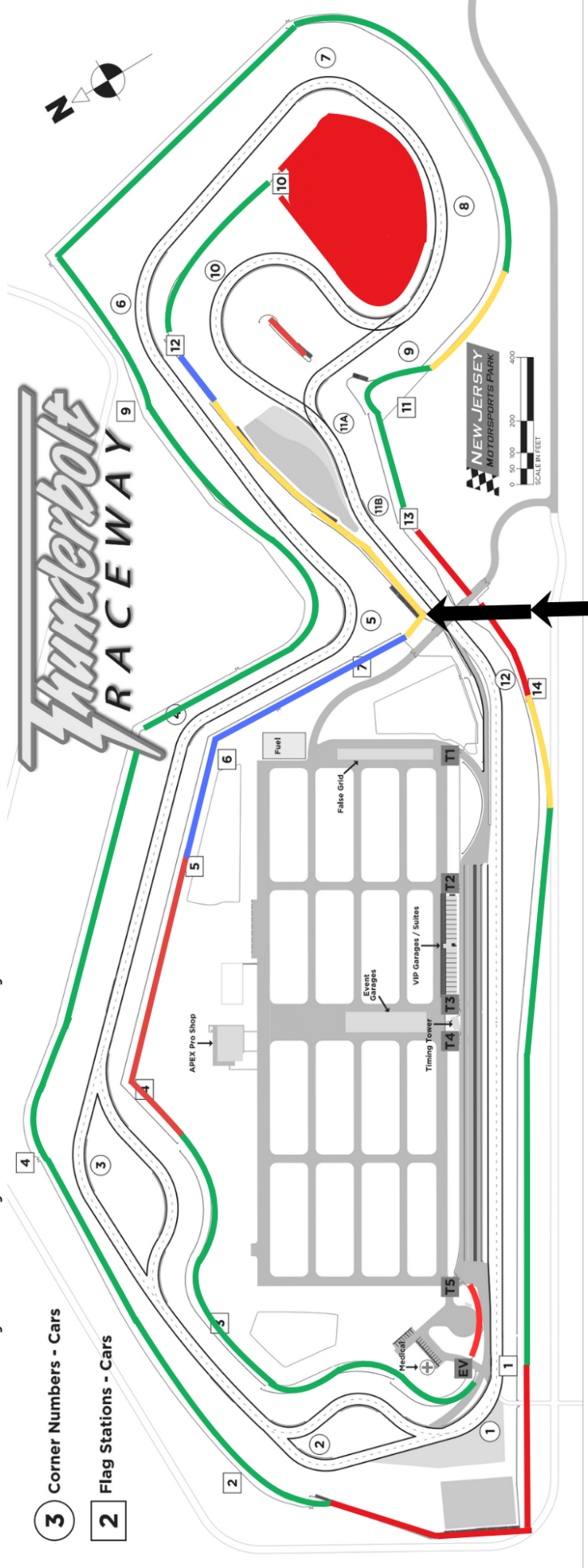


Photographer Guidelines

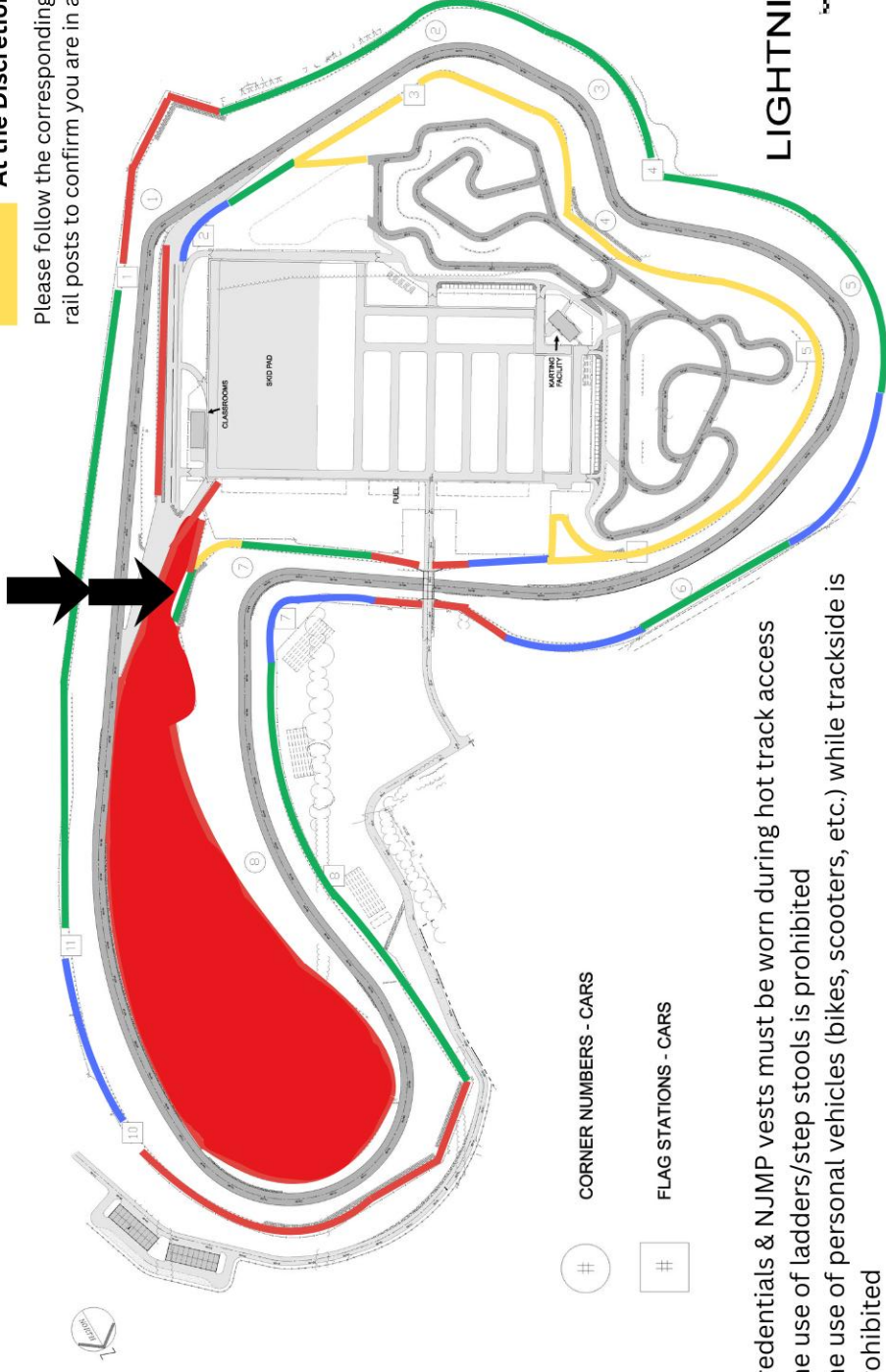


Photographer Guidelines

Please See gate guard LO/L1 for approval to enter - please stay between the two green cones

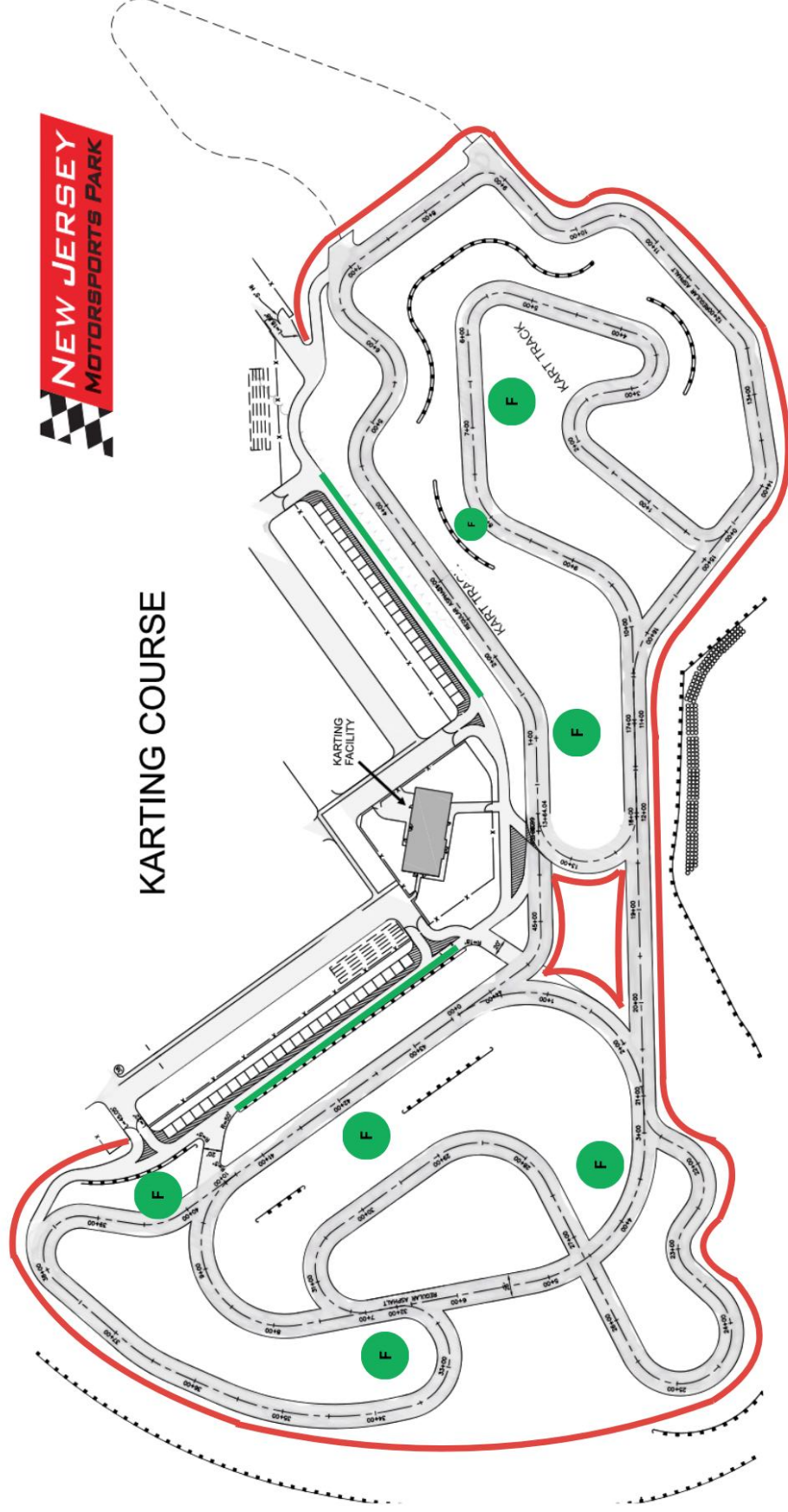
Photographer Guidelines - Go-Karting

- Credentials & NJMP vests must be worn during hot track access
- The use of ladders/step stools is prohibited
- Sitting & Standing on barriers is prohibited
- Access is NOT Permitted through the ambulance/wrecker gate
- **NEVER CROSS A HOT TRACK.** Wait for karts/bikes to be fully pitted in before crossing to the next location. Please coordinate with the karting staff on when to cross the track
- NJMP Security has final say on access and safety issues

- You must be behind tire bundles, barriers, and/or Flag stations. Coordinate with the karting staff on when to get to your desired acceptable location
- No emittance on the side between karting track and big track
