



2026 Riders Club Membership By-Laws

Purpose

The purpose for which the Club is formed is to establish, maintain and operate a private racetrack membership organization with its focus on motorsport and other automotive related activities including a members-only track days and benefits that include facility discounts, preferred track rental rates, reciprocal track membership rights and amenities that include clubhouse, two road courses, swimming pool, karting facility, and other recreational facilities as from time to time may be determined to be desirable by management.

Membership

Any person of good moral character who is discreet, financially responsible and enjoys a good reputation for being a truthful, peaceful and law abiding citizen, of the age of eighteen (18) years or older, if an individual, who may desire to become a member of the Club or ride during club days, shall present, or cause to be presented, to the Club office, an application for membership or registration, on the form approved and supplied by the Club management.

Any person or organization applying for membership to The Riders Club at New Jersey Motorsport Park shall be deemed to have authorized the management to conduct a creditworthiness check and a general background and character check on such person or entity.

Members should never speak to any NJMP employe or vendor in a derogatory manner. If a member fails to follow the rules, they may be removed from the club and the facility. A prorated amount of the Membership Fee will be returned to the removed member.

No applicant shall be considered for membership until he, she or it has paid the necessary, required fees and charges for membership as set forth on Motorsportsreg.com.

Racecourse Rules

The Club expects the on-track behavior of members to be above reproach.

All Riders must comply with Chapter 62 of the New Jersey Motor Vehicle Racetrack Regulations. A copy of the Regulations may be requested from the Club Administration office.

The Riders Club Director, or any of the authorized agents, may suspend any member's riding privileges at any time for conduct that jeopardizes the safety of the facility or other members. On track sessions will range from single sessions allowing passing only in designated areas, up to and including events open to motorcycles under race conditions.

To participate in a Riders Club Member event, a member must 1.) Certify that he/she has no known physical or mental impairments that could jeopardize themselves or others if he/she participates in Riders Club events and 2.) Agree to abide by the Membership Bylaws regarding the conduct of the Member Driving Day events.

Track damage

Members and guests are responsible for any damage to the track, guardrail, tire barriers, and the like that may occur while they are at NJMP. An invoice detailing the cost of the damage will be issued.

Member Conduct Policy

All Members of the Riders Club are hereby advised that **disrespectful, defamatory, abusive, or threatening conduct** toward **New Jersey Motorsports Park (“NJMP”) Ownership, Employees, Management, Contractors, Emergency Services Personnel, or any individual representing NJMP in any capacity** is strictly prohibited.

Such conduct includes, but is not limited to, **slanderous remarks, verbal outbursts, intimidation, harassment, or any other behavior that may be reasonably construed as hostile or inappropriate** toward NJMP representatives.

All complaints concerning member behavior shall be reviewed by the **NJMP Disciplinary Committee**, which may include one or more of the following individuals: the **NJMP Managing Members, President, General Manager, Chief Financial Officer, and Director of the Riders Club**.

Upon review, if a complaint is deemed valid, **disciplinary action shall be taken immediately**, which may include **suspension or termination of membership** without further notice.

In the event of membership termination, the member shall be entitled to a **pro-rata refund of current membership**.

All members are expected to conduct themselves in a manner that upholds the integrity, safety, and professionalism of the New Jersey Motorsports Park community. Failure to do so will result in disciplinary action, up to and including permanent expulsion.

Guests

The Rider’s Club is a private exclusive membership club at NJMP. Our goal is to provide participation for all members, and limited number of guests. During the season NJMP will host member-only events limited to current Riders Club members only and not open to guests, staff, or non-members.

Members may not publicly promote the use of the Club for guest riding purposes through social media or other methods of public outreach and may not sublet or resell guest participation.

Guest participation is an incredibly special membership privilege and must be managed as such to maintain the private integrity of the Club.

Youth Riders

All members must possess a valid, current Driver’s License to participate in a Riders Club track day. At the Club’s discretion, youth riders of at least 13 will be permitted to ride providing they possess a current competition license recognized by the Club, i.e., ASRA/CCS, MotoAmerica, WERA, NJMini GP etc., and said youth riders will be monitored for competence on an ongoing basis per the following process.

Process: Upon the club's receipt of the youth Rider's competition license, the club will conduct a review of track rules, observe the rider on track, and evaluate competence and riding skills on a quarterly basis to assure a safe learning curve to benefit the rider and the club. The Club reserves the right to revoke riding privileges for the safety of the rider and other riders on track.

Private Riding Coach/ Instructors

All non-NJMP coaches and instructors must be pre-approved by NJMP Riders Club Safety and Coach committee to instruct and coach at Riders Club events.

Session Classifications for Use of the Racecourses:

Members are permitted to run in one group only and not permitted to participate in multiple run groups.

White Group – Intro

Sessions will be lead & follow format, following the lead intro school instructor, pacing the session. Other Riders Club Coaches will follow the class.

Yellow Group - Novice

Our novice classifications are called the Yellow Group
Sessions will be lead format.

Red Group – Intermediate

Red Group is for intermediate level Riders. This group will also serve experienced riders who prefer a moderate speed group. Access to this group will be at the Club's discretion. Riders who have successfully completed multiple Red Group / Intermediate Events may graduate from the Advanced group upon their request and with three coaches' recommendations as well as approval from director of the club.

Blue Group – Advanced

Advanced allows competent, experienced riders to explore, in a controlled environment, the limits of themselves and their bikes. Advanced is NOT a competitive environment and passing is approved in all approved track locations discussed at the mandatory drivers meeting. Receiving a promotion into Expert groups requires three coaches' recommendation as well as the director of the club's approval.

Black Group – Expert

This group will include all expert riders and racers. Passing rules will be similar to the Advanced Group sessions.

Equipment Rules and Technical Inspection

All Riders Bikes & helmets are subject to a daily Tech inspection.

Chapter 62

All Riders must comply with Chapter 62 of the New Jersey Motor Vehicle Racetrack Regulations. A copy of the Regulations may be obtained from the Club Administration office or on our website at www.njmp.com.

Safety Requirements for Passing Groups

Vehicle and driver gear must comply with Chapter 62 of the New Jersey Motor Vehicle Racetrack Regulations. A copy of the Regulations may be obtained from the Club Administration office or on our website at www.njmp.com NJMP reserves the right to determine who will be considered an approved instructor. All Riders must have a full-face helmet, gauntlet style gloves, riders boots that cover the ankle and a full leather suit made of animal hide.

Garages

Riders Club Members will pay a premium rate on daily garage rentals during Riders Club Events only.

Release Form & Regulations

Track Management may post supplemental regulations in a public area near the entrance to each configuration of the circuit for the purpose of amending or supplementing the rules and regulations. To ensure general safety and efficient operation of the racecourses, each member shall, by signing the general liability release upon entry to the facility, acknowledge understanding and acceptance of these and all supplemental regulations. It is the responsibility of the members to read, understand and accept these rules and regulations before use of any racecourse or motor sports facility. If there is meaningful change, the supplemental regulations for the use of any racecourse shall be mailed to the members.

RV/Trailer Storage

Members may leave a trailer/RV on the grounds at NJMP's current rate. NJMP will designate a parking area outside of the paddock for this purpose. Members must notify go to Guest Services with their intentions to leave a trailer/RV prior to doing so. You must fill out the RV/ Trailer Storage Form and place the trailer tag that Guest Services gives you on your trailer.

Riders Club Schedule

The club Schedule will be available at the start of the season. Any changes to the schedule will be published immediately after change is made. Members must make reservations on days they plan to attend. Reservations will be accepted on a first-come, first-served basis.

Member Day Fees, Payments, and Cancellations

Registration takes place on the selected registration platform for all categories of riders and guests. Members and guests are encouraged to register as far in advance as possible to assist the Club in planning of services. The Club will charge the registrant credit card upon registration.

Full refunds will be provided to members cancelling their participation 48 hours or more before the start of the event. Refunds **will not** be granted for cancellations received within less than 48 hours of the event starting time. Cancellation requests must be made on motorsportreg.com by the attendee. Non-members / Guests must cancel seven (7) prior to the event date to receive a full refund. The cancellation must be done on Motorsportsreg.com by the attendee.

VIP Suite Discount – Riders Club Members will receive a Special Member daily rate for all Riders Club days. This special discount applies to members only. Members are permitted to reserve up to (2) rooms per membership for guests when available. To receive discounts, members must make reservations on-line in advance along with payment for all room(s) requests. Reservations not made in advance or not made online will not be entitled to the member discount rate.

Electric

Paddock electric is complimentary to all attendees during Riders Club events.

Camping

Camping is complimentary to all attendees during Riders Club events

Annual Waiver

Members are required to sign the annual waiver at the time they receive their member Hangtag.

Stopping at Front Gate with your ID

Members are required to always stop at the main gate and show their hangtag before proceeding to their park destination.

Private Track Rentals

Riders Club Members are eligible for preferred track rental pricing set each year by the Track Operations Team. The rental contract must be paid for by the Member and must be contracted under the Member’s name only. No subletting will be permitted. Private track rentals may not be advertised to the public and are intended to be a private test day.

Additional Rules and Regulations:

1. New Jersey Motorsports Park does not allow anyone to carry weapons, firearms, and anything similar, onto the property of NJMP, regardless of if you have a license to carry firearms
2. Cannabis is NOT permitted to be carries or consume on NJMP property at any time
3. New Jersey Motorsports has the right to update or change the benefits, at any time to include rates, or rules/regulations during the year.
